First-crop 2-year-olds race this year

A precocious juvenile, **Heatseeker** won his first start in July of his 2-year-old season and followed with an August allowance win at 7½ furlongs then a Group I placing in his third start at 2.

At OBS April, Arnold Zetcher and Zayat Stables purchased 2-year-olds from his first crop for **\$115,000** and **\$85,000**.

First-crop foals now arriving

In his first year at stud, 37 of 41 mares bred to **Thorn Song** were pronounced in foal. First-crop arrivals at Harris Farms include an April 3 filly out of Grade I winner **Alphabet Kisses** (\$590,271).

Thorn Song (\$1,132,700) is the leading money winner and only Grade I winner by his sire at stud outside of Kentucky.

First-crop foals now yearlings

A 6-figure sales yearling and graded winner of over \$1 million, **Desert Code** won five stakes from 6½ furlongs to 1 1/16 miles, including the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (now G2).

Thirty registered yearlings from his first crop include half-sisters to California Champion **Unzip Me** (G3, \$959,228) and undefeated **Starry Skies**.

LUCKY J. H.

First-crop 2-year-olds race this year

An unusual "win early" son of **Cee's Tizzy**, **Lucky J. H.** graduated at Del Mar by 7 lengths in his second start at 2, setting fractions of :22 2/5, :45 3/5 and 1:10 for a final time of 1:11 3/5.

A graded winner of \$632,065, **Lucky J. H.** ranks second only to **Tiznow** among his sire's leading earners at stud.
